

You are to use the sites located at www.baumansworld.com on the Asia page to find answers to the questions below. You will put your answers on your own sheet of paper. The links you need are listed in order.

1. Click the link to a story entitled: **Thirty Years On**. It has a picture of Deng Xiaoping with it. Describe the effect that allowing capitalism has had on the Chinese people. Include both the positives and negatives and issues this might also cause for the government.
2. Go back and click on **key people and events**. Select Tiananmen Square. Explain what happened there, when and why.
3. Go back. Click on link **Locked Up**. Explain what seems to be happening to people who complain to the government. Be specific on how they are treated and also the types of complaints they have. How might things for these people now end up being better?
4. Go back and click on the link **How China is Ruled** and select. Click on Communist Party. Describe:
 - a. The organization of the party, who is in the party and how one joins.
 - b. How you become part of the leadership.
 - c. The types of decision the party makes.
5. Click on **Politburo**. Describe:
 - a. What it is and the powers it has.
 - b. Who is on it and how to you become a part of the Politburo.
6. Click on **National People's Congress**. Describe:
 - a. How many members and how they are selected.
 - b. Powers it has/what it does.
7. Click on **Courts and Prosecutors**. Explain how their court system has a different purpose than ours.
8. Go back and select **In Graphics: Modern China**.
 - a. Select Population. Describe changes in its population.
 - b. Select Poverty. Describe changes in the poverty level and who is in poverty.
 - c. Select Environment. Describe the environmental problems caused by economic growth.
 - d. Select Social Change. Summarize the changes.
9. Go back and click on **Taiwan: future flashpoint?** Click on Present Status. Explain what the situation is between China and Taiwan. Also, who does the U.S. side with?
10. Go back and select **Inside Isolated Tibet**. Read the introduction and then click on History. What is the relationship/conflict between China and Tibet?
11. Go back and select **Deep concern over Three Gorges**. Explain:
 - a. What Three Gorges is.
 - b. Environmental problems caused by the project.
 - c. Government viewpoint
