Your script for the presentation should be completely written out in the notes section of the Google Docs presentation. You need to cover all the required elements plus one of the optional elements (whichever suits your topic best) in your slides. Your final three slides will be articles you recommend that the President read while in flight. Each of these slides should include an article citation and an abstract that **you have written**, about the article. The articles need to be found in one of the following Library databases: SIRS, EBSCO, eLibrary, or Proquest.
