In order to be a knight of the realm of Bauman you must complete parts 1 & 2 below by **Wednesday, November 21<sup>st</sup>**. Points will be given based on accuracy, quality of design/product and originality. Most will receive between 10 and 15 points. See below for opportunities for more points!

To enter the tournament you must prove your noble heritage. You can do this by completing the following tasks:

1. **Create your own Coat of Arms/Shield design.** You can use the sheet with the shield outline that I provide and/or is on my website or can make your own. It can be done by hand or with computer. You are to design it in the proper fashion of heraldry. To find out what this is go to [www.baumansworld.com](http://www.baumansworld.com), click on the World History link and then look up information on the various heraldry sites in the Medieval section.

a. Your Coat of Arms/shield design must include the following which represent who you are:

- i. Color(s) – includes type of metal (see Blazon)
- ii. Symbols
- iii. Pattern(s)
- iv. Blazon (technical description of your coat of arms)

Ex. *Argent, a saltire azure, cantoned with four markings of ermine sable* =



2. **Create a motto.** It can be in English/Latin/French or whatever you find.

It should be phrase that you feel you live by and is unique to you. Feel free to look at sites online to help you.

**For more points!** Build your own shield/helm/breastplate. Choose one or all three! Keep them in the same color scheme as your coat of arms and include the coat of arms on the shield. Use wood, metal or cardboard, just have fun and be as accurate as you can. You can build these by yourself or with a squire.
